CBRFC UNDER15s SIX NATIONS TOUR TO THE REPUBLIC OF IRELAND SEASON 2011 TO 2012

I am pleased to inform you that the outline details of the Under 15s tour schedule to the Republic of Ireland can now be released, and that the necessary planning has commenced and your positive commitment is now required. The outline of the tour is as follows and further timescales will follow later in the pre season break:

Friday 3rd February 2012.

Leave early from the rugby club about 06.30am

Travel to Holyhead and catch the early morning sailing to Dun Laoghaire, Republic of Ireland

Play rugby in the afternoon against an East Glendalough School Co Wicklow followed by after match hospitality.

Travel to our accommodation at the Glendalough Youth Hostel in Glendalough Co Wicklow.

A team evening dinner at the Hostel.

Saturday 4th February 2012

Breakfast at the Youth Hostel.

Travel to Wicklow town.

Play Wicklow RFC in Wicklow in the morning followed by post match hospitality.

Afternoon at leisure with some sightseeing in Dublin or some outdoor activities (to be determined)

Evening dinner at local hotel or the hostel (to be determined).

Sunday 5th February 2012

Breakfast at the Youth Hostel

Travel in the morning to Dublin and play Old Wesley RFC followed by post match hospitality.

Travel across Dublin to the AVIVA stadium to watch the IRB Six Nations opening match Ireland v Wales at 15.00 hours.

Return to hostel

Evening Dinner and Tour awards ceremony either at hostel or local hotel (to be determined)

Monday 6th February 2012

Breakfast at the Youth hostel

Travel to Dublin for sightseeing and visit to Croke Park Stadium Dublin for organised tour

Return by Ferry (times to be determined) to Holyhead

Return to Club house.

As can be seen the programme is comprehensive and this programme has been developed working in partnership again with Tours 4 Ltd who organised our French tour in March 2011.

However in order to ensure that this 4 day tour goes to plan a substantial effort will have to be expended by the players, the parents, and the team management. This will include team fund raising by means such as sponsored walking, team bag packing to fund the tour directly, corporate requests for subvention, as well as players and adult social fund raising events in the CBRFC club house. In short if you do not participate in the fund raising we will not be able to tour and we need total team fund raising commitment.

Please note that we will only have about **28** playing places on this tour and only 8 adult places are eligible. The numbers are limited due to the extreme scarcity of International tickets for the IRB Six Nations Match which we have managed to secure already through our host clubs in Ireland by paying up front. Only players who have in September re-registered for the season, undertake training, play for the club, fund raise, and pay their deposit on time will be able to tour. In relation to adult travelling places those will be offered first to the CRB cleared parents who supported previous tours.

The headline price is yet to be determined but it will not be any more than last year hopefully less. However as we have only got 9 months to fund raise before we go on tour, (and we will endeavour to reduce the price) this will only occur if the funds from outside the club flow in.

For budgeting purposes a deposit of **£125.00** will be required payable to CBRFC in cheque format only please before **Sunday 25th September 2011**. Please put the name of your player on the back of the cheque please when making the payment. We need this slightly payment earlier than last year to fund the International Ticket application and the tour is six weeks earlier in the season than last year. A further payment will be required (yet to be determined) by **30th November 2011**.

Please note if all goes well we are off to Italy in 2013 as part of our Six Nations Touring Objective an playing Italian Clubs and participating in International Rugby Tournament.
